² Transport fees increase annually on July 1st in the amount equal to the CPI-Urban index for San Diego published the preceding January by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, and then rounded up to the nearest \$10 increment (3.9% to 4.2%). Per mile charge will be adjusted annually on July 1st based on the budgeted cost to purchase, maintain, and operate all ambulances, divided by the total loaded miles from the previous year and then divided by the current collection rate (updated July 2025) .

³ The 100% markup in the cost of each individual medication accounts for the City's costs, in the aggregate, associated with acquisition, storage, use, record-keeping and replacement of medications used by the Emergency Medical Svcs personnel.
