ABOUT MEASURE X

In 2018, Oceanside voters recognized a pressing need to maintain and enhance public safety services and invest in City infrastructure. Thanks to Measure X, an EMT program was developed and two new ambulances were purchased. This has resulted in increased emergency response capabilities, and reduced medical call times. An additional Homeless Outreach Team with a Social Worker was established, a Sobering Services Center was founded, and funding for crime suppression was expanded. Measure X is also facilitating a historic investment in revitalizing heavily used public spaces such as roads, beachfront areas, and the Pier. A new downtown Fire Station is in the planning stages, which will help accommodate necessary apparatus and equipment.
