OVERNIGHT OVERSIZED VEHICLE PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

The purpose of the program is to allow a City of Oceanside resident to purchase a temporary permit for parking of an oversized vehicle or unattached trailer/non-motorized vehicle on the street overnight due to special circumstances. Oversized vehicle is any vehicle or combination of vehicles that exceeds 25 feet in length, or 84 inches in width, or 84 inches in height. Any extension(s) caused by mirrors or accessories attached to the side(s) of such vehicle shall not be considered part of the measured width area. Unattached trailer/non-motorized vehicle is any trailer, travel trailer, tow dolly, semi-trailer, boat trailer, utility trailer, or any other vehicle without means of self-propulsion. (Oceanside Traffic Code Sec. 10.28.1). **Vehicles participating in the permitting process cannot have a gross vehicle weight of 10,000 pounds or more (OTC 10.14).**

The City reserves the right to withhold the sale of any permit until all outstanding parking citations have been cleared.

(RULES AND REGULATIONS CONTINUED ON REVERSE SIDE)

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- **Permits will only be issued to City of Oceanside residents.** Proof of residency may be demonstrated by:
 - A currently valid lease or other rental agreement; or
 - A currently valid utility bill showing service and mailing to the resident applying for the permit at the address in which the vehicle will be parked.
 - Proof of registration of the motor vehicle for which the permit is assigned showing the registered owner's address at the address in which the vehicle will be parked; or
 - Proof of current voter registration at the address in which the vehicle will be parked; or
- Permit date is the day the **permit is valid from 12:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.** For example, if the oversize vehicle needs to be parked from 10 p.m. December 31 to 7:00 a.m. January 1 the requested permit date should be January 1. Permit dates cannot be changed once approved. The City is not responsible for incorrect permit request dates and citations will not be dismissed for incorrect dates.
- Non-refundable permits may be purchased **up to two weeks in advance of the requested use date.** Requests received without appropriate documentation or **received within 2 hours from close of business are not guaranteed to be processed same day.** The City is not responsible for delays in permit issuance due to DMV verify denial or failure to submit valid documentation within the allotted timeframes. Citations will not be dismissed for failure to obtain permit.
- Annual oversize vehicle permits require 72 hours for processing once all required documentation is received by the City. The City is not responsible for delays in permit issuance due to DMV verify denial or failure to submit valid documentation within the allotted timeframes. Citations will not be dismissed for failure to obtain permit.
- **Non-transferable virtual permit is assigned to the residential address and properly registered vehicle plate on the application.** P.O. box, offsite mail box, commercial address or addresses within an industrial zone will not be accepted as a residential address. A vehicle that has been assigned a permit shall display the vehicle's license plate(s) pursuant to the California Vehicle Code and follow all other provisions of State and City Vehicle and Traffic Codes.
- **The size of vehicle, location, or condition must not pose a public hazard** (OTC 10.28.3).
- Vehicles assigned permits must abide the **seventy-two-hour (72) maximum** (OTC 10.4) parking regulations and all other applicable parking laws and regulations. No more than three (3) consecutive 24-hour period permits will be assigned at a time.
- Vehicles parking on public property shall not be connected to any utility at any time (OTC 10.29).
- Permits are **not valid during street sweeping hours.** Vehicles must be moved during posted street sweeping times. Please locate the nearest sign posted on your side of the street for street sweeping days and times. (OTC 10.3.1)
- Permits are **not valid in any city parking lot or at any metered space** (OTC 10.28.3). Permits are not valid in time-limited parking zones.
- No vehicle which is over seven (7) feet in height, as measured from the street and including any item affixed to the top of the vehicle, shall be parked on that portion of Pacific Street between Wisconsin Avenue and Surfrider Way (OTC 13.26).
- The program shall not relieve any property owner from any obligation imposed by any zoning ordinance or land use regulations to provide on-site, off-street parking spaces as a requirement of development.
- The City reserves the right to withhold the sale of any permit until all outstanding parking citations have been cleared.
- Any disregard for the ordinance, program rules and regulations, or the misuse of the oversized vehicle parking permit will result in citations being issued and/or immediate suspension or revocation of assigned permit(s). The owner of the vehicle will be held responsible for any citations issued. **Citations will not be dismissed.**
