Utility Release / Solid Waste Recycling Authorization

The City of Oceanside is committed to provide quality service for residents and business of Oceanside.

Oceanside City Code 13.3(A) requires that all persons shall dispose of solid waste and recycled waste in the manner provided by city code. Additionally, OCC 13.16 outlines the process for disposal through the authorized collector and sets fee for services, which are provided.

When a property is approved for occupancy with the completion of the "Utility Release and Occupancy Authorization" card, residents may move into the property and commence paying for services and utilities.

AB939 is a state law, which mandates the reduction of 50% of solid waste disposed in California landfills by municipalities. The City of Oceanside is required by State law to provide recycling services for identified materials and green waste, through our designated franchise waste hauler.

The Developer must provide the street name and address of the new service locations to the franchise waste hauler, Waste Management of North County at (760) 439-2824. The waste hauler will deliver to the developers at the job site location, the number of recycling crates and carts for placement at each new residence. The waste hauler shall be required to deliver the containers within 14 working days of Occupancy.

The Developer must submit a letter for each new address to certify that all necessary containers have been delivered.
